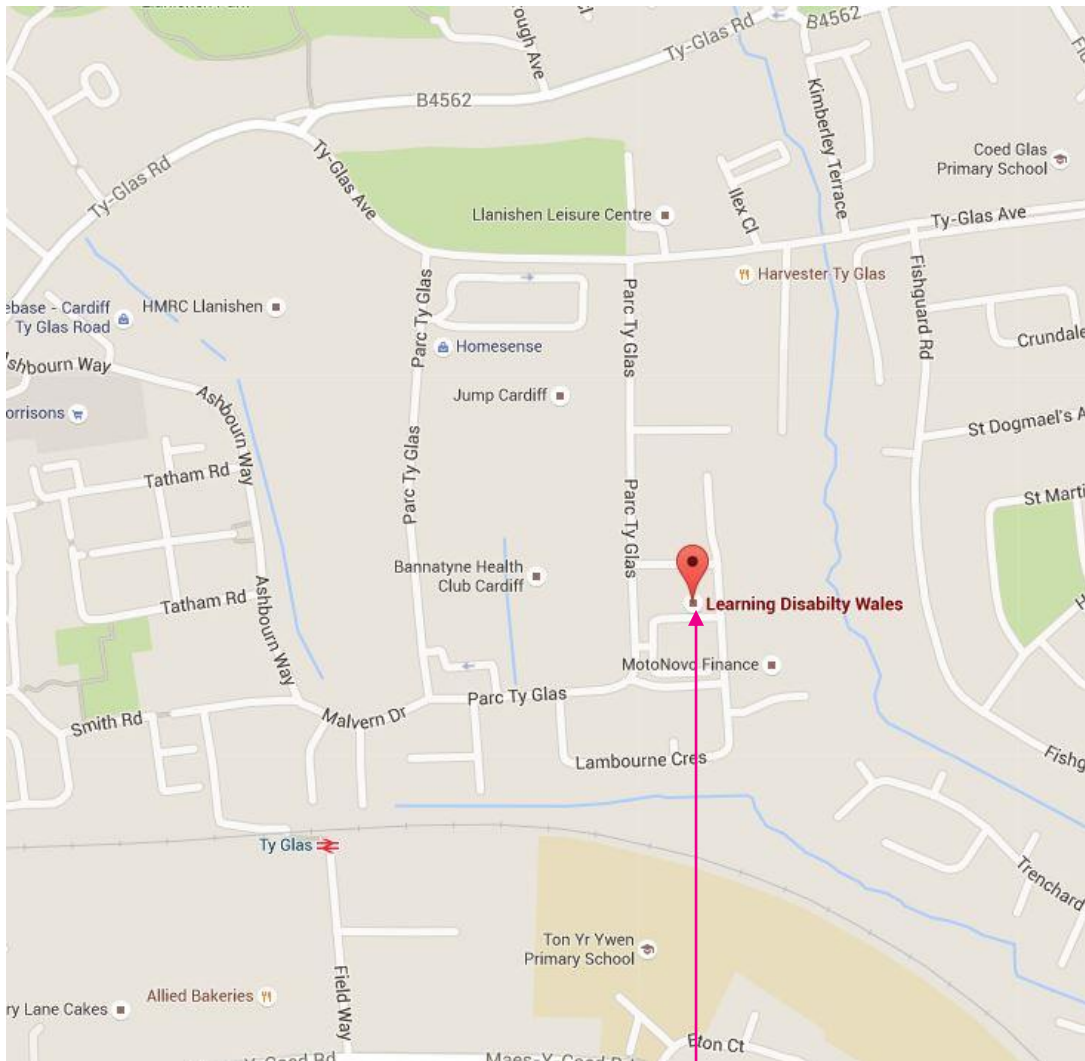

Learning Disability Wales

TRANSPORT LINKS & TRAVEL OPTIONS

Learning Disability Wales is a short distance from Cardiff City Centre and is easily accessed from the M4 and by bus or train.

BY CAR

From the M4 by car:



- Leave the M4 at junction 32 and take the A470 to Cardiff.
- Stay on this road until you see the Tesco Express garage on your left. Turn left just before the garage.
- Stay on this road and go through 1 set of traffic lights.
- At the next traffic lights turn left (you will see a Lidl supermarket opposite).
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Ty Glas Road.
- Pass the Inland Revenue offices and stay on this road with M&S and Boots to your right. Turn immediately right after M&S onto Parc Ty Glas.
- Turn left immediately after S4C.
- Learning Disability Wales is at the end of the road, on the right.

From Cardiff City Centre by car:

- From the city centre take A470 North Road.
- Continue ahead over Gabalfa flyover to the traffic lights (stay in the right hand lane).
- At the traffic lights follow signs for A469 (Caerphilly Road).
- Follow Caerphilly Road for about one mile.
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Ty Glas Road.
- Pass the Inland Revenue offices and stay on this road with M&S and Boots on your right. Turn immediately right after M&S onto Parc Ty Glas.
- Turn left immediately after S4C.
- Learning Disability Wales is at the end of the road, on the right.

CAR PARKING

There is ample parking in **Cardiff Business Park**.

You can park in any parking bay numbered 41 either outside of Learning Disability Wales or to the rear.

If no numbered parking bays are free, there is additional road side parking available.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Learning Disability Wales is well served by buses and trains.

The nearest railway station is **Ty Glas** and is about 5 minutes walk away.
