

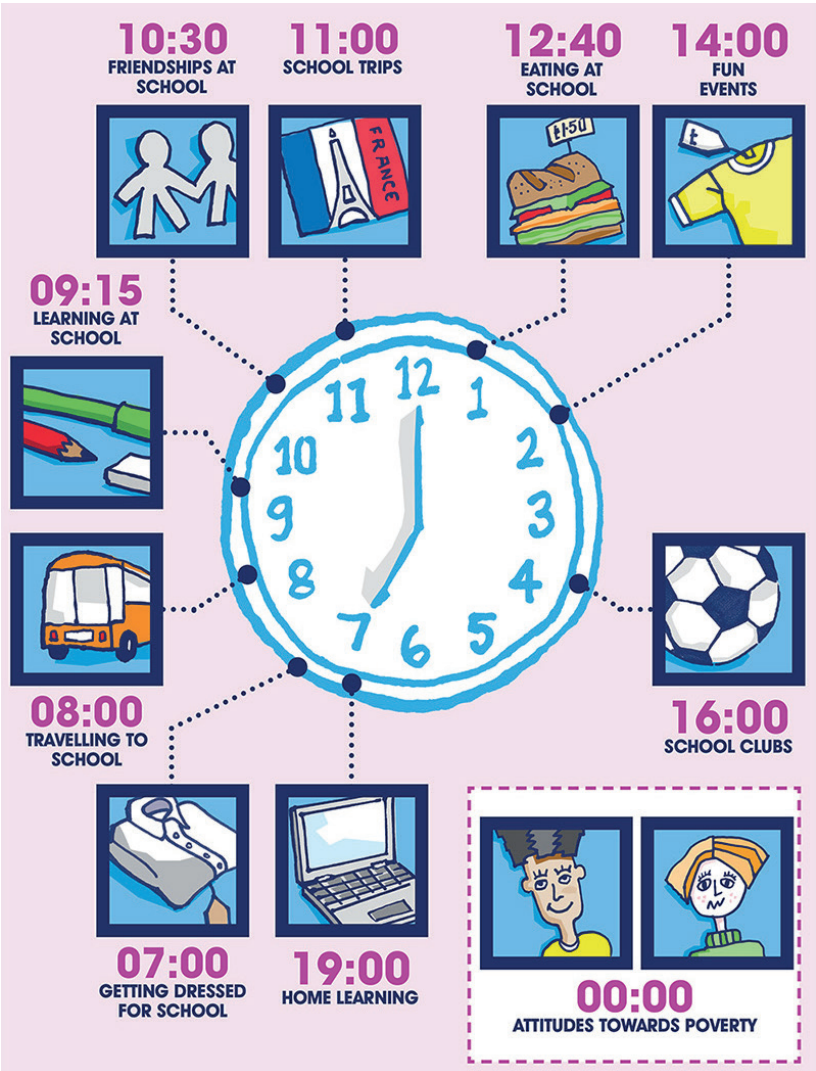

Write a school costs survey

An activity to help you find out what others at school think about costs and which ones might be a problem.

This is a good way to reach lots of people and get their views. You could design surveys to find out what other pupils, parents and even members of staff think about costs.
